GENERAL INFORMATION

The IDC contains both the Assistant Instructor (AI) and Open Water Scuba Instructor (OWSI) courses. Candidates who have successfully completed the OWSI or IDC programs qualify to attend the Instructor Exam (IE).

The Dive Experience Instructor Development program also includes the Emergency First Response Instructor class (EFRI).

IDC Pre-requisites:

To enroll in an **AI or IDC** an individual must:

Be certified as a PADI Divemaster or hold a leadership level certification with another recognized* recreational scuba diver training organization.

In addition, all candidates must:

1. Be at least 18 years old
2. Have been a certified diver for at least 6 months and have completed and logged at least 60 dives with documentation of experience in deep, night and navigation. Note: logs must be submitted to Barbara.
3. Be fit for diving and submit a Medical Statement signed by a Physician stating that the candidate is fit for diving. This must be signed within 12 months of the IE.
4. Submit proof of CPR and First Aid Training within the last 24 months.
5. Submit copies of any equivalent (non-PADI) certifications for entry-level, advanced, rescue and leadership-level issued by another recreational diving organization.
6. Be a current Emergency First Response Instructor or equivalent. The EFRI is included in the Instructor Development program.

IE Pre-requisites

1. Have successfully completed all portions of an IDC or OWSI within 12 months of the IE start date.
2. Be fit for diving and submit a Medical Statement signed by a Physician stating that the candidate is fit for diving. This must be signed within 12 months of the IE.
3. Have completed and show proof of at least 100 logged dives including deep, night and navigation.

IE Exit Requirements

Certification as an EFR Instructor or equivalent
